RESPONSIBILITIES: Ensures that the City of Dayton water treatment plant operation and maintenance is in compliance with all regulatory standards in order to provide high quality, economical, softened and safe water to the public. Under general direction from the Water Supply and Treatment Administrator has great autonomy to direct the water treatment plant operation and maintenance activities; assumes the lead role as the Operator of Record in a back-up capacity per OAC 3745-7. Acts as the lead person for the plant for daily safety issues and provides safety training. Responsible for all operational and maintenance shifts of a 24/7 operation; has a thorough understanding of lime softening water chemistry; controls the proper inventory of chemicals, materials and equipment parts. Responsible for a \$3,000,000 operating budget. Must be a functional user of SCADA.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Bachelor's degree in engineering, chemistry, environmental science or related field and 2 years of experience in the operation and maintenance of a water treatment or lime reclamation plant; 1 year of this experience must have been in a supervisory capacity; OR associate's degree in the above fields and 5 years of experience listed above; 1 year of this experience must have been in a supervisory capacity; OR high school diploma (or G.E.D) and 8 years of demonstrable and progressive responsibilities/accountabilities in the experience listed above; 1 year of this experience must have been in a supervisory capacity. Must possess an Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) Water Supply Class III Operator's license at time of appointment and maintain said license. Must possess a valid driver's license at time of appointment. Must obtain and maintain a valid Ohio Driver's License within 30 days of appointment.

NOTE: Applications must specifically address each of the minimum qualifications, directly showing how each is met. Degree must be from a college or university that is accredited by the U.S. Department of Education through the North Central Association of Colleges and Universities (or equivalent region).

Your online application must be submitted by March 8, 2010. A complete position description may be obtained from the Civil Service Board Office.

GENERAL EMPLOYMENT REQUIREMENTS

Final permanent appointment is contingent upon the applicant passing a job-related medical examination and providing documentary evidence of Employment Authorization and Identity.
